

## Senior Timeline: September - December

### September 9/21: **FINANCIAL AID NIGHT @ CUHS LIBRARY** 6:30 – 7:30 pm - English & Spanish Presentations

- Finalize decisions as to which colleges you will apply. There are fees for submitting UC/CSU applications. Community College applications are free of charge.
- Sign-up to take or retake the SAT I, SAT Subject Tests, or ACT if needed. See October dates below.
- Two SAT Subject tests may be required for some UC's. Check the website for information regarding SAT Subject Tests and certain majors.
- Pay attention to SAT/ACT registration changes effective this year. Check the SAT/ACT websites for details.
- If you haven't already, you should visit campuses you are planning to apply to.
- Applying to a private university? Application deadlines vary, check your dates!
- Questions: Visit with Ms. Seay for college/university information.
- Update your resume—your list of accomplishments, involvements, and work experiences—with your senior year activities. Your resume will help you complete your applications and essays.
- Ask teachers/counselors to write letters of recommendation (if required for your application). Supply a resume to anyone writing you a letter of recommendation.

### October

10/7: **SAT I & Subject Tests** offered at CUHS

10/30: **College Night @ Cuesta College 5:30 – 8:30 pm** (*free transportation provided*)

- CSU (California State University) applications are available for submission 10/01. Get to work; applications are reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- See a counselor if you need help or have questions.
- Start working on UC (University of California) essay questions.
- Early Admissions Applications are available for some universities, check your dates!
- If you plan to play college sports and haven't signed up for NCAA Clearinghouse, the time is now!
- SAT and ACT tests are still being administered, some universities will not accept scores after the October test date, check your dates!
- If required for university applications ask your counselor, teachers, coaches or employers for letters of recommendation. Give them plenty of time to meet deadlines and make sure to provide a copy of your resume
- If you applied for EOP (Educational Opportunity Program) be sure you've asked for letters of recommendation and completed all necessary paperwork.

### November

- UC applications are available for submission November 1 – November 30
- UC essays should be in the final stages. Make sure to ask for feedback and proofreading before sending them off.
- ***Finish UC and CSU applications by the end of the month.***

### December

- Begin looking at Scholarship Information
- Local Scholarship Information will be passed out in your Government class
